 **PWS&D** **Esmy's Story of Entrepreneurship in Malawi** - In the heart of Balaka District, Malawi, lives Esmy Edward, a 44-year-old single mother of five. Esmy's journey is a testament to her own resilience, as well as the transformative power of community development initiatives.

Not long ago, Esmy faced overwhelming challenges. *"Life used to be tough,"* she recalls. *"Providing food and paying school fees for my two sons in secondary school felt like an impossible task."* However, her story took a hopeful turn when she became a participant in the Enhancing Climate Resilience for Improved Income and Food Security project through PWS&D partner CARD.

Through the project, Esmy learnt about financial management, and participated in a village savings group. She also received training on modern farming techniques, and obtained five goats, whose organic manure improves her farm's productivity. Today, her herd of goats has grown to 10, thanks to her diligent care and the sustainable practices she adopted.

This income has enabled her to cover the school fees for her two sons, ensuring they can continue their education without interruption. *"I am grateful for the support I have received,"* Esmy says.


