 **PWS&D** "The lack of drinking water in the home is tiring and disappointing," explained 28-year-old Carolina Coronado.

"During this year, the water pressure of the piped [municipal] system has decreased a lot. We have asked the community authorities for the expansion of drinking water, which hasn't been possible due to the low water pressure." To help respond to this challenge in Guatemala, PWS&D, together with our partner, the Maya-Mam Association of Research and Development, provided water tanks to families in need. Carolina explains: "The water tank will be very useful to me. Now I will be able to continue planting vegetables in my family garden. I am very grateful."


