PWS&D Responds to Serious Drought in Somalia –

Men and women living in Gedo region of Somalia used to

make ends meet by farming and raising livestock. Yet, in 2015, a rainy season without enough rain devastated the crops of many and put their animals at risk of starving. In 2016, nothing changed.

Today, drought, exacerbated by climate change, is still making it difficult to put food on the table.

Gedo is home to over 735,000 people. Having fled political conflict in other parts of Somalia, a staggering 3,000 internally displaced persons are also dependent on the sparse resources of this region. Every one of these people who goes to bed hungry is one too many.

PWS&D is supporting a Canadian Foodgrains Bank project that sets up clinics for children, pregnant and lactating women to be assessed for malnutrition and receive fast, effective treatment. Plumpy'nut, a peanut paste fortified with vitamins, nutrients and protein, is administered to children under five, and caretakers receive three daily meals so they too can have strength for tomorrow.

Through this program, important training is also given to new mothers - now, they have hope to prevent malnutrition in those they love through proper breastfeeding and income generating activities.
